Introduction to the Association

Types of membership

We have three categories of membership, Corporate, Associate and Individual.

Corporate membership

Corporate membership is for organisations where wind is a core activity. Turbine manufacturers and large generators are expected to become corporate members.

Corporate membership enables these organisations to participate in the industry at a strategic level, helping to shape the NZ wind industry's future.

Associate membership

Associate membership is for organisations that have wind as one part of their activities. It is also for small companies (less than 5 staff) that focus on the wind sector, and international companies with a very small regional presence (1-2 people).

Associate membership provides opportunities to actively participate in NZ's wind industry, including business development and networking.

Individual membership

Individual membership is for people who are not connected to a commercial company. It enables academics and representatives of community groups to learn about the wind industry and support its development.
