3 years ago in Paris...

- Paris Agreement adopted 12 Dec 2015
- 175 Parties sign on April 22; a record
- Also record entry into force, within a year (4/11/16)
- Transformation of the global economy











Some misconceptions...





Rumours of the PA's death have been greatly exaggerated...

- 185 Parties have ratified so far; 195 signatories (of 197 Parties to the Convention)
 - Job mostly done Paris
 Agreement Work Programme
 complete



The Paris Agreement Work Programme

 Details(rules and guidelines)fleshed out concluding at COP24 in December 2018:



Countries' reporting; review; tracking progress towards targets; communicating financial support; the global stocktake; communicating future NDCs... but





nothing agreed on carbon markets

Aims in the negotiations...

- 6.2 developing robust accounting procedures -so that reductions aren't counted by more than one country
- 6.4 rules for a new central unit-producing project mechanism, its supervising body etc

Obstacles in the negotiations...

- Countries that resist rules that would require them to count back in the reductions they sell abroad
- Questions about the old systemKyoto units and projects
- Anxieties about the interface with CORSIA the international aviation deal


